Targeted

Vulnerable Children and young people whose needs are more complex.

Level 3

- Early Help Assessment
- · Whole family plan
- Team Around the Family (TAF)
- Targeted parenting programmes
- Early Help support coordinators
- Children and Families' Hub consultation
- Children and Families' Hub referral for Family Wellbeing Service (when needs cannot be met within existing accessible resource)

4 Special<u>ist</u>

Children and young people whose needs are complex and significantly impacting on child development or wellbeing.

Level 4

- Children and Families' Hub consultation
- Children and Families' Hub referral for Children Social Care
